European meeting 26th October 2024 in Parma.



The meeting was arranged by the Friends of Pilotta, Parma. Concert and reception at the Palazzo Ferrari-Pelati with a light meal on the Friday.

The meeting the next day was in the old and beautiful Palatina Library in the catalog room of the library. Nine countries participated with a total of 13 persons.

The meeting in Parma had two purposes. First, to share experiences from the Second European Day and agree on the third. Second, to discuss the future work of WFFM as proposed by the Executive Committee. An underlying objective was to meet members and reignite the spirit of our organisation.

WFFM has had a decline in membership and an analysis has shown that there has been a structural decline over the years. A SWOT analysis was presented for WFFM as an attempt to show the strengths and weaknesses of the organisation.

The Executive Committee's primary effort is to increase membership. One of WFFM's main functions is to exchange information between members. The VPs have been tasked to increase membership in their world region – both by recovering previous members and attracting new members.

At the end of the day, we were shown some old and valuable books, some of them more that 1000-year-old that is kept under lock.

WFFM Young Friends project 2024

WFFM sent a letter to the national federations asking to nominate one or two young friends to the WFFM Young Friends Project 2024, WFFM and Young Friends.docx - Google Dokumenter. For this first meeting with newly nominated Young Friends 14 young friends participated and represented 8 countries. We asked them to organise a workshop at the upcoming General Assembly in June 2025 in Naples. This project is in line with the Plan of action for the new Executive Committee. There was a discussion how this group of new friends would organise themselves. The present group has been nominated by their federations. Discussed also how to establish a Young Friends Council.

The participants agreed that the countries should be represented, not the individual persons. This will secure continuity and also give the National federation a responsibility. The group will select a country to be the leader for one year, and then circulate among the countries. WFFM will send a letter to the federations, explaining the structure of organizing this Young Friends project.

Web site

Initial work on a new website has been undertaken. Plan to replace our present website in February.
