# Taranto Conference on "Museums, landscapes, environment and sustainability"



The Taranto National Conference entitled "Museums, landscapes, environment and Sustainability" was divided into three days, 8, 9, and 10 November 2024. Friday afternoon saw the Apulian associations as protagonists. Friends of the Museums of Brindisi, Friends of the Museums of Corato, and Friends of the Pomarici Santomasi Foundation of Gravina with a series of reports



aimed at illustrating the activities of enhancement and protection of the environment, related to the geographical and socio-economic contexts of origin. All the paths started to promote awareness of the landscape as a common good and cultural heritage that must be told and enhanced were illustrated. Experiences and paths were presented to promote awareness of the landscape as a common good and



cultural heritage to be told and enhanced.

On the morning of November 9th, the Conference focused on various contributions that explored the Mediterranean agricultural landscape and the urban and port landscape in industrial cities. In the afternoon, general issues related to territorial planning, landscape plans that include the relationship between city and countryside and urban health were addressed. On Sunday 10th there were several speeches related to the topics of rural historical landscapes and the relationship between environmental and economic sustainability and cultural identity.



## Congress of the French Federation of Friends of Museums in Lyon April 4<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> 2025

The Friends of the Musée des Beaux-Arts de Lyon will welcome the next congress of the French Federation from April 4 to April 6 in Lyon. This year, Friends of Museums will discuss on the theme of "Networking: working together more effectively".

We'll focus on developing exchanges between Friends of Museums, enabling them to work together and share experiences, and to raise

the profile of our associations by opening to external partners (supervisory bodies, institutions, media...).

François Jullien, philosopher of international notoriety, will close the congress on the singular bond that the Friend maintains with his museum over time. He will write a book on this existential bond to be published early 2026. We are expecting a strong turnout of 200 Friends of Museums, including more than 50 Young Friends.
